Duties & Responsibilities:

- Monitor the criminal underground where cyber criminals congregate and speak Portuguese.
- Research specific threat actors to determine who they are, their motivation and their criminal tactics, techniques and procedures (exploit kits, malware kits, cash out procedures, bulletproof hosting, etc.);
- Produce succinct written reports of research findings and work collaboratively to identify knowledge/information gaps.

Qualifications, skills, knowledge or experience in (any/all of the following):

- Experience leading, mentoring, and managing small teams of researchers or analysts;
- Monitoring or researching the criminal underground and various cyber-criminal services and business models;
- Researching/attributing cyber threat actors using open and closed sources;
- Solid understanding of operational security aspects of conducting cyber threat research online;
- Knowledge of how malware or other malicious tools/techniques are leverage by threat actors.
